

# Memorandum of Association Of

## **DHAKA UNIVERSITY MBA ASSOCIATION**

(Under Section 28 of the Companies Act, 1994)

- A. The name of Association shall be **“Dhaka University MBA Association”**.
- B. The Registered Office of the Association shall be situated in Bangladesh.
- C. The objects for which the Association is established are all or any of the following and all the objects will be implemented after obtaining necessary permission from the Government/ Concerned authority/ Competent authority before the commencement of business.
- D. The objectives for which Association is established are :-
  1. To build better professionalism for better business development, better society, better Bangladesh & ultimately for better world.
  2. To promote and advance the professionalism in all its branches of business administration throughout Bangladesh and abroad.
  3. To build a common platform for career networking, relationship and bridge the gap among the MBA graduates, MBA students, Teachers of Faculty of Business Studies, University of Dhaka, well wishers and professional bodies.
  4. To promote the study of business administration with a view to disseminating information obtained, for facilitating business and economic development of Bangladesh.
  5. To create and develop professionalism by organizing seminar, symposium, workshop & training programs.
  6. To promote the members of the Association by providing scholarship, internship, employment opportunities & career counseling.
  7. To regulate the professional activities and assist in maintaining high standards in the general conduct of its members.
  8. To establish a ‘Center of Business Administration’ in Bangladesh for advancement of knowledge and experience.
  9. To establish a Club of ‘Dhaka University MBA Association’ in abbreviation DUMA Club.
  10. To participate in various social activities for the social welfare, development and integrity.
  11. To help in the acquisition and interchange of professional experience among its members.

12. To promote the professional interests and welfare of its members.
  13. To encourage research in business development & economic utilization of the country's resources.
  14. To foster co-ordination with similar Association in Bangladesh and in other countries, for mutual benefits in furthering the objects of Association.
  15. To diffuse among its members information on all matters affecting business administration and to encourage, assist and extend knowledge and information connected therewith by establishment and promotion of lectures, discussions or correspondence; by holding of conferences, by publication of papers, periodicals and journals, proceedings, reports, books or other literary undertaking; by encouraging research works or by the formation of library or libraries and collection of models, and articles of interest in connection with business administration or otherwise whatsoever.
  16. To co-operate with various Government agencies and Industrial and Commercial enterprises connected with advising them in matters concerning the profession and practices of business development and promotion of education in business administration.
  17. To encourage inventions and investigate & make known their nature and merits.
  18. To arrange and promote the adoption to equitable forms of business contracts and other documents to encourage settlement of disputes by arbitration and to act as and nominate arbitrators and umpires on such terms as may be expedient.
  19. To promote just and honorable dealings and to stop malpractices in profession.
  20. To do all such other acts and things as are incidental or conducive to the above objects or any of them.
- E. With a view to the better attainment of its objectives. The Association shall use its best endeavor to establish Centers, sub-centers and Students Chapters in various areas in Bangladesh and Overseas Chapters countries and take other steps for the benefit of members in such manner as the By-Laws for the time being to The Association shall prescribe.
- F. There shall be general meetings of all classes of members from time to time and there shall always be a Governing Body called the Executive Committee to direct, manage and execute the concerns of The Association in between two General Meetings; and only the General Meetings of Corporate Members shall have supreme authority regarding the entire direction and management of The Association according to Bye-Laws framed hereinafter by majority votes, the Chairman of the meeting having a casting vote. The Corporate Members as per provisions of the Constitution and Bye-Laws shall choose the Executive Committee which will make and establish Bye-Laws necessary for conducting

the business of The Association or alter, vary or revoke and make such new ones as it may think most useful and expedient.

- G. The whole property of The Association is vested solely and absolutely in members thereof and that shall have full power and authority to sell, alienate, charge or otherwise dispose of the same as they think proper, but no sale or mortgage, encumbrances or other disposition of any property, lands, tenements, belongings to The Association shall be made except with the approbation and concurrence of a General Meeting. Under no pretence whatsoever, any such property or effects or the income or revenue derived from voluntary contributions or otherwise be applied in making any dividend, gift or bonus between any of the members and the same is hereby expressly prohibited provided that it shall be lawful for the EC to grant honorarium to a member who has rendered or has been rendering special service to The Association.
- H. No resolution or Bye-Laws shall on any account or pretence whatsoever be made by The Association in opposition to the general scope, true intent of the Laws of Bangladesh and if any such rules and Bye –Laws are made, the same shall be absolutely null and void.
- I. The Association shall not carry on any trade or business or engage in any transaction with a view to pecuniary gain or profit of the members thereof. No member shall have any personal claim on any property of The Association or shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend or bonus or otherwise, whatsoever, by way of profit to the members of The Association.
- J. To borrow or raise money required for the purpose of the Association to receive money, or deposit, from the members of the Association and to invest or otherwise deal with the money of the Association upon such terms and in such manner as may be determined by the Association.
- K. To purchase, construct, take on lease or in exchange, hire or in any other way acquire any movable or immovable property or properties and any rights and privileges which the Association may think necessary or convenient for the purposes of carrying out any of its objects and to sell, demise, mortgage, give in exchange or dispose of the same or any part thereof.
- L. To accept any request, gift, donation or subscription towards any fund or endowment or waqf and to establish and support, or aid in the establishment of any funds, institutions and trusts purported to benefit the members of the Association, its employees or ex-employees or their dependents and to subscribe or guarantee money for any charitable or benevolent object or for any public, general useful objects.
- M. To arrange for giving relief, medical or otherwise, to the member of the Association, its employees or ex-employees or their dependents whether they be poor, needy or otherwise either by establishing and maintaining hospitals dispensaries, nursing homes or other

institutions of similar nature, aiding by subscription, donations or otherwise, which are or may hereafter come into existence, and;

- N. To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the above subjects.
- O. The income and property of the Association whatsoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion and attainment of the objects of the Association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of profit or dividend to the members of the Association provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of expenses or of remuneration to any employees of the Association or member thereof for the services rendered to the Association.
- P. The fourth paragraph of this Memorandum of Association is a condition on which the license is granted by the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh to the Association in pursuance of Section 28 of the Companies Act, 1994.
- Q. If upon winding up or dissolution of the Association there shall remain after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities and property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid or distributed among the members of the Association but shall be given to some other society or institution or institutions having similar objects as may be determined by the votes of not less than 3/4<sup>th</sup> of the members present personally or by proxy at the time of dissolution, or in default thereof by such judge of the High Court as may have or acquired jurisdiction in the matter.
- R. The liability of the Members is limited.
- S. Every member of the Association undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Association in the event of the same being wound up during the time that he/she is a member or within one year afterwards, for payment of the debts and liabilities of the Association contracted before the time at which he/she ceases to be a member and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up the same and for the adjustment of rights of the contributories among themselves such amount as may be required not exceeding **Tk. 2,000/- (Two thousand Only)**.
